

If The Shire[™] is at the heart of *The Lord of the Rings*, then the Hamilton and Waikato region is at the heart of The Shire.

When scouting around for settings for his epic three movie adaptation of *The Lord of the Rings* Trilogy, Kiwi Director Sir Peter Jackson found just what he was looking for in the green paddocks of the Waikato just outside Matamata.

The bucolic setting for The Shire, home of the Hobbits, including Bag End, was right there, and just waiting for his magical director's touch.

Whilst the cast and crew have gone, the visitor today can easily imagine Hobbits going about their business, as well as being a tribute to the Kiwi film-makers and artists who created it.

Visiting Matamata and the Hobbiton $^{\text{TM}}$ Movie Set is not just all about Hobbits though. Hobbiton Movie Set is located on a working farm and allows visitors not only to 'walk in the footsteps of Hobbits' but to also discover the true rural diversity of the area.

This manual offers a true taste of New Zealand with tours developed by New Zealanders for visitors from around the world.



The story of Hobbiton Movie Set

In 1998, Sir Peter Jackson's team of location scouts were searching for the iconic rolling hills and lush green pastures of Hobbiton™. An aerial search led them to the Alexander farm, a stunning 1,250 acre sheep farm in the heart of the Waikato.

They noted the area's striking similarity to The Shire $^{\mathsf{TM}}$, as described by JRR Tolkien, and quickly realised that the Hobbits had found a home.

In one particular part of the farm, a magnificent pine tree towered over a nearby lake, adjacent to a rising hill. Bag End now sits atop that hill, overlooking the Party Tree, as that pine would later be known. The surrounding areas were untouched; no power lines, no buildings and no roads in sight. This meant that Sir Peter Jackson could leave the 20th century behind, and fully submerge himself in the fantasy world of Middle-earth™.



In March 1999 the crew began the nine month quest to bring the ideas for Hobbiton to fruition; help was provided by the New Zealand Army, and soon 39 temporary Hobbit Holes[™] were scattered across the 12 acre plot used for the set. Secrecy was key, and strict security measures were put in place by the production company throughout construction and filming. Filming commenced in December 1999, and it took around three months to get a wrap on The Shire.

After an initial attempt at demolition, 17 bare plywood facades remained. These shells would serve as the catalyst that propelled Hobbiton forward into the public eye, with tours commencing in 2002.

In 2009, Sir Peter Jackson returned to film *The Hobbit* Trilogy, and he left behind the beautiful movie set you'll see today; 44 permanently reconstructed Hobbit Holes, in the same fantastic detail seen in the movies. There's an abundance of movie magic nestled inside the fully operational farm.



A tour of Hobbiton Movie Set

Hobbiton Movie Set is an experience to tantalise the senses of visitors from all across the globe, as guests find themselves engulfed in the sights, smells, sounds and tastes of The Shire, at the home of the Hobbits, as featured in *The Lord of the Rings* and *The Hobbit* Trilogies.

The extraordinary following that the movies have amassed has led to our tours becoming a 'must see' while travellers are in New Zealand. The Hobbiton Movie Set is the only set that remains intact from the trilogies, and that allows our visitors to fully immerse themselves in the wonders of The Shire.

Visitors are given the once in a lifetime opportunity to see an iconic movie set in its

full glory; from wandering the rambling paths of The Shire, to seeing the submerged Hobbit Holes that litter the rolling hillsides.

Fall in love with the Alexander family sheep farm, just as acclaimed director Sir Peter Jackson did, as you journey through the unequivocal beauty of the land, with the mighty Kaimai Ranges towering in the distance. Your guide will then escort you around the set, showing you the intricate detailing, pointing out the most famous locations and explaining how the movie magic was made.

Journey past the colourful Hobbit Hole doors that scatter the hillsides, including the iconic Bag End, home of Bilbo and Frodo Baggins, before arriving at Bagshot Row for a glimpse of the interior of a humble Hobbit's home.

Designed and crafted by the renowned creative teams behind the film trilogies, Bagshot Row offers an authentic glimpse into the charming dwellings of Hobbits going about daily life in the Shire. Your guide will lead you through one of two Hobbit Holes offering time to explore the detailed interiors, with each home designed to create an identical experience.

Continue along the pathways past The Millhouse, across the double-arch stone bridge and into the world-famous Green Dragon™ Inn, where you will enjoy a complimentary, exclusive beverage to conclude your own Middle-earth adventure.

After the 'ceremony' the gardens are the perfect location for champagne and canapés while the happy couple have photos with friends and family.


YARD FLAT

Yard Flat is a spacious private location situated on top of the iconic Hobbit Holes providing a stunning view over the movie set towards the lake and iconic Party Tree. THE GREEN DRAGON™ INN

The Green Dragon Inn is a fully reconstructed replica of the pub featured in the Trilogies, which has been masterfully recreated creating an unforgettable venue for your special day. This exceptional, exclusive venue is perfect for you to enjoy your wedding reception as you indulge in our exclusive Southfarthing $^{\text{TM}}$ ale, cider and ginger beer and enjoy a dinner fit for a Hobbit from our professional in-house catering team.

The Green Dragon Inn is a fully themed venue where guests can enjoy their delectable dinner in the main dining area or head down to bar area to enjoy a dance. With open indoor and outdoor fireplaces this venue encourages your guests to spread out between the spectacular interior or beneath the outdoor glowing lanterns making for a truly magical wedding reception.

THE PARTY MARQUEE

The Party Marquee is a stunning, spacious venue for larger wedding parties or those couples wanting a little extra space. The painted canvas exterior, vibrant bunting and colourful lanterns allows your group to be immersed in the festive magic of the movies while you celebrate your special day.

The Party Marquee is situated adjacent to the Green Dragon™ Inn and is placed upon the hillside providing an exquisite view for all guests. Like the Green Dragon Inn, the Marquee has a fully licenced bar and catering is tailored to your menu choice by our professional in-house team.

THE MILLHOUSE

The Millhouse, is a fully themed venue located on the 12-acre movie set, just across the water from The Green Dragon Inn.

The Millhouse is an expertly crafted venue offering the same warm, inviting atmosphere of The Green Dragon, but in a more intimate setting. The exposed wooden beam ceilings, hand carved details, the crackling fire place and curated decor create a cosy setting for a banquet-style wedding meal by the fireplace beneath the hanging candelabrum. This self contained venue comes complete with it's own in-built drinks station to serve our exclusive Hobbit $^{\text{TM}}$ Southfarthing $^{\text{TM}}$ range in our signature ceramic mugs or goblets, alongside a range of house wines, coffee and tea.

CAPTURE THE MEMORIES OF YOUR SPECIAL DAY

Holes scattered throughout the landscape, our venue is ideal for photographing beautiful wedding images.

Hosted by a Hobbiton Movie Set tour guide, Wedding Photoshoot guests have 2.5 hours to explore the Movie Set and capture some of the most iconic shots in The Shire.

Walk hand-in-hand past the lakefront Hobbit Holes with your reflection dancing on the lake, stroll along the Party Field with incredible views of The Green Dragon Inn, and visit the vegetable garden where hobbit holes lie hidden in the hillsides.







Securing a photographer for your wedding photoshoot is the responsibility of the couple, however recommendations for local options can be made on request.

3:50pm Groom, groomsmen and celebrant arrive at the Shire's Rest™ and are transported to the ceremony

4:00pm Guests arrive at the Shire's Rest[™] and bus to the ceremony location

4:10pm Bride, bridesmaids and photographer arrive and are transported to the ceremony location

4:30pm Ceremony begins

5:00pm Ceremony concludes. Drinks, canapés and family photos begin

5:45pm Bridal party depart for a fully guided photoshoot tour

5:55pm Guests begin their fully guided tour of Hobbiton™ Movie Set

6:55pm Guest tour enters Bagshot Row interior Hobbit Hole

7:05pm Bridal party photoshoot tour enters Bagshot Row interior Hobbit Hole

7:20pm Guests arrive to The Green Dragon Inn for a pre-dinner drink

7:30pm Guests are seated

7.40pm MC announces the arrival of the bridal party

7:50pm Mains are served

8:30pm Speeches

9:00pm Cutting of the cake 9:15pm Dessert is served

9.45pm First dance

11:45pm Last drinks are served

12:00am Departure

- Use and set up of Hobbiton equipment including tables, chairs, cutlery, crockery, glassware, PA and sound system. Additional items requested will be charged to the final account with prior arrangement).
- Two on-site consultations.
- Dedicated event coordinator on your wedding day.
- Printing of supplied seating plan.
- Tour: Tour cost is included for bride and groom, all guests must experience the tour at rates specified above.

It is the responsibility of the couple to secure both a celebrant and a photographer for your wedding, however recommendations for local options can be made on request.

Terms, conditions and cancellation policies

Terms and conditions

- Toilet facilities are available at Shire's Rest[™] Cafe, the entrance to the Movie Set, The Millhouse and at the Green Dragon[™].
- Menu items and dietary requirements for functions need to be advised at least 72 hours prior.
- Sensible walking footwear is required.
- · All prices are retail and in NZ\$.
- All prices are GST inclusive.
- Tours and activities operate in all weather conditions, umbrellas are provided in the event of rain.
- In the event of extreme weather conditions we reserve the right to make alternative tour arrangements.
- Please note that no tours are able to access the set without being accompanied by a Hobbiton tour guide. The set is located on private property and is still operated as a working sheep farm.
- Foreign language information We have a companion app STQRY that has key written information in 16 different languages.

Reserving your date

To reserve your date we require confirmation in writing and a non-refundable deposit of \$1,000 is required. 30 days prior to your event date, we require a 50% payment of the total event cost. The remaining outstanding balance will be sent in a final invoice shortly after your event.

Final numbers

For catering and operational purposes, final numbers are required at least 72 hours prior. The final numbers will be the minimum number invoiced for.

Dietary requirements

We cater to all dietary requirements. Any dietary requirements that apply to your group must be advised 72 hours prior to your chosen date.

Host responsibility

- If you are intoxicated you may be refused admission
- We have a strict host responsibility policy and intoxicated persons may be refused service and asked to leave
- Please ask for Health and Safety Policy prior to your event

Damages
